Keynote Session: World Class Healthcare for Team USA: The Olympic & Paralympic Experience

Jonathan Finnoff, DO, FACSM, FAMSSM, RMSK

We are excited to share that Jonathan Finnoff, DO, FACSM, FAMSSM, RMSK, will be presenting the Keynote Session at the PRISM Annual Meeting, World Class Healthcare for Team USA: The Olympic & Paralympic Experience.

Dr. Finnoff is the Chief Medical Officer for the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee (USOPC) and a Clinical Professor in the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at the University of Colorado School of Medicine in Aurora, CO.

Dr. Finnoff is board certified in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation and Sports Medicine. Dr. Finnoff has published over 100 articles in peer reviewed journals, authored multiple book chapters, and co-edited a book with Mark Harrast, MD, titled "Sports Medicine: Study Guide and Review for Boards". He has been a faculty member or course director for numerous national and international conferences, is currently the President of the American Medical Society for Sports Medicine (AMSSM) Board of Directors, previously served on the American Academy of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (AAPM&R) Board of Governors, and is a current member of the World Anti-Doping Agency's Therapeutic Use Exemption Expert Advisory Group.

Dr. Finnoff was a team physician for the United States Ski Team for nearly two decades prior to his role with the USOPC and has provided medical coverage for the ski team at the Olympics Games, World Cups, and World Championships. Dr. Finnoff has served as the Chief Medical Officer for Team USA at 4 Olympic and 4 Paralympic Games. Dr. Finnoff's research and clinical interests are broad and include multiple sports medicine topics such as elite sport injury and illness epidemiology, injury and illness prevention, Paralympic athlete health, elite athlete mental health, advanced diagnostic and interventional ultrasound and exertional leg pain.
