- Instructional Course Lecture (ICL) Workshop

ICL Format: Include a series of in-depth scientific lectures on topics relevant to pediatric sports medicine with a focus on didactic instruction.

Workshop Format: Consist of interactive demonstrations on topics relevant to pediatric sports medicine with a focus on audience participation. Workshops should include hands-on instruction in specific techniques, skills, or competencies that result in practical skill acquisition (e.g., diagnostic ultrasound, therapeutic modalities, treatment techniques, research methods).
