Clinical and community coverage opportunities include three local school districts, two private schools, a large regional sports complex, the Governor's School for the Arts, local road races, and numerous club sports organizations.

Qualifications

Qualified candidates should have completed a **pediatric** residency and fellowship training in primary care sports medicine. Physicians with post-fellowship experience are preferred; however, all qualified applicants will be considered.
